



## Pyramid Support at Home Activity Plan

### Activity: Bucket Toss

**Description:** This is a simple take on a carnival type game that you can set up and play easily in a home or other learning environment. There are options for you to utilize a variety of materials. This mini game can be played socially with multiple participants taking turns or you can teach your learner to play against themselves solo, just trying to get the ball or bean bag into the bucket.

**Materials:** Bowls, buckets, bean bags, or some type of balls
