
Universal No

The Universal NO Page is designed as a unique page for use in our Small and Large PECS Communication Books where we move pictures of items that are unavailable.

Assembly

Apply strips of hook fastener vertically on either side of the NO symbol as shown in diagram

*pictures are sold separately



Early in PECS, we try our best to honour all requests. Not all items are always available, though! We use a variety of strategies to visually signal that an item is not available: we show an empty container, we offer alternatives, we use a token card to signal when the requested items can be 'earned,' or we signal that the learner needs to 'wait.'

Sometimes the item is just not available, and we are unsure when it will be. Never remove pictures* from a learner's PECS Communication Book!

The Universal NO Page is designed as a unique page for the PECS Communication Book where we move pictures of items that are unavailable. The learner can still exchange a picture but will learn that if the picture is on the NO page, the item is not available. Once the item is available again, move it back into the book where it is normally stored.
